The Museum is open every day except:

- Monday to Friday of the second week in January.
- From 24 December at 12:30pm to 26 December at 2pm.
- From 31 December at 12:30 to 2 January at 2pm.

Opening hours:

Summer, **15 March to 15 November:**

9:00 to 18:30 non-stop (till **19:00** from May to August)

Winter, **16 November to 14 March:**

9:30am to 12:30 and 2pm to 6pm

Warning!

Ticket sales stop **45 minutes before** the museum closes.

Duration of the visit

The recommended visit takes **an hour and a half** (interpretation room, cinema and Tapestry Gallery)
